#### Day 1

## Wednesday, February 12, 2020

We depart Little Rock and land at the Mexico City International airport. We then meet our English-speaking guide and make a short stop for a welcome Mass at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe. We depart for Puebla. Overnight.

#### Day 2

#### Thursday, February 13

Puebla is a city in east-central Mexico, southeast of Mexico City. It's known for its colonial architecture, pottery and culinary history. The painted Talavera tiles adorning numerous buildings are locally produced. The Renaissance-era Puebla Cathedral has tall

bell towers and overlooks the central square, the Zócalo.



Museo Amparo offers an extensive display of pre-Hispanic art, such as ceramics and mural fragments. Mass will be celebrated at Rosary Chapel followed by a visit to the

Cathedral Church of San Francisco to see the incorrupt body of Blessed Sebastian of Aparicio and other points of interests in the historic center. Lunch is included at a local restaurant. We will have the rest of the afternoon for leisure to explore on our own. (Breakfast, lunch)

#### Day 3

#### Friday, February 14

After breakfast, we depart for Mexico City, stopping on the way to visit San Miguel del Milagro, the site of miraculous apparitions of St. Michael to Diego Lazaro in 1631 and visit the well of healing waters, continuing to the basilica in Ocotlan, where Our Lady began appearing to Juan Diego Bernardino (no relation to St. Juan Diego) on February 27, 1541, and see another healing well. We will have lunch at a local restaurant and then arrive in Mexico City. Overnight at retreat center. (Breakfast, lunch and dinner)

#### Day 4

#### Saturday, February 15

Today, we make a brief stop at Tlatelolco, the Plaza of the Three Cultures prior to attending private Mass at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe and an extensive visit to the grounds, seeing the Chapel of the Indians, the Sacred Well and Tepeyac Hill. We will continue to the Pyramids of Teotihuacan to see (and climb) the pyramids of the Sun and the Moon and Butterfly Temple. A buffet lunch will be served at a nearby popular restaurant with lively ambiance, live music and native dancers. We continue back to Mexico City with a stop to Tulpetlac, site of the 5th apparition. Overnight. (Breakfast, lunch and dinner)

#### Day 5

#### Sunday, February 16

We begin the day today with public Sunday Mass at the Church of the Holy Family where Blessed Miguel Pro's



remains are found. Father Pro was persecuted during the Cristero War, or *Cristiada*, and killed by a firing squad in 1927. We will have time to visit the small museum on the grounds that tells about his short life as a priest. We will then head to the south of the city to visit the Church of St. John the Baptist and further south to Xochimilco to the "Floating Gardens" of Mexico to enjoy a gondola ride along the flower-laden canals. We will experience the lively atmosphere of mariachis, salterio and marimba groups that are found along the canals.

We will end the day with a farewell dinner. (Breakfast, lunch and dinner) Optional performance of the Mexican Folklore Ballet at the Palace of Fine Arts (at a surcharge).

#### Day 6

#### Monday, February 17

After breakfast we will transfer to the airport for our flight home, leaving with great memories to last us a lifetime. (Breakfast)

**Tour Prices:** All prices in this brochure are based on land rates and exchange rates in effect at the time of printing and on group rates of 40 passengers per bus. Tours may depart with less than the required number of passengers, at the discretion of Group IST, LLC (doing business and referred to herein as "Regina Tours"), but an additional charge may apply. Passengers will be advised about such surcharges 60 days before departure. All prices are subject to change without notice prior to departure due to major currency fluctuations and/or unforeseen economic circumstances.

#### **Reservations, Deposits and Final Payments:**

Please complete the Participant Agreement, with full names as they appear on passports, and mail it to us with the required per-person deposit. Deposit of \$500 is required at the time of registration to hold your spot. A second payment of \$500 is due by November 18. The final balance is due by January 9. If the final payment is received after January 9, a late fee will be assessed in the amount of \$50 per late payment. All payments made by check should be made payable to Sue Smith Vacations (referred to herein as SSV). Credit card payments will be subject to a 3% processing fee.

Late Reservations: If a booking is made within 60 days of departure, full payment is due at the time of booking. There will be a \$50 late processing fee applicable plus cost of any express or overnight mail services.

Travel Documents: A valid passport (valid for six months after the return date of the trip) is required to travel. Visa is required for U.S. passport holders traveling to some destinations; please contact our office for details. All non-U.S. citizens must contact the appropriate consular office for entry visa requirements pertaining to their trip. In addition non-U.S. citizens are responsible for complying with requirements for re-entry into the U.S. SSV/Regina Tours assumes no responsibility for procurement of passport or visas. Obtaining and carrying these documents is the sole responsibility of passengers. SSV/Regina Tours will not be responsible for any delays, damages and/or losses, including missed portions of your trip due to improper travel documentation.

**Final Documents:** All documents and tickets are only issued upon receipt of final payment and are sent within three weeks of departure. Documents are not guaranteed if final payment and booking form are not received on time.

### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

Air from Home City: Air from LIT is included in the package. All other gateway options are considered on a case-by-case basis. Sue Smith Vacations is providing air travel for the people traveling on Arkansas Catholic's pilgrimage to Mexico in February 2020.

**Rooms:** Prices are per person, based on two persons sharing a hotel room. A limited number of single rooms are available for an additional charge of \$100. Triple rooms are available in many hotels for family or friends traveling together. There are no discounts for triple rooms.

**Medical Conditions:** While we endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers, we cannot guarantee special facilities or assistance for disabled passengers and it is your responsibility to arrange for such assistance as required. We regret that we cannot provide individual assistance. SSV/Regina Tours is not responsible for any medical conditions that may occur prior, during, or after the tour.
